Prior to McAfee, DeWalt oversaw customer operations and sales at EMC Corporation and was also responsible for EMC's content management and archiving software business.

DeWalt joined EMC in 2003 when EMC acquired Documentum, the global leader in enterprise content management, where he served as president and CEO for more than two years, leading the company through nine consecutive quarters of growth, five record revenue quarters, and four successful acquisitions.

DeWalt has more-than 20 years in the technology industry—spanning engineering, product management, marketing, and sales management. He has held positions at companies including Eventus Software, Segue Software, Quest Software and Oracle Corporation.

DeWalt is a frequent guest on international business programs, and appears regularly on Bloomberg TV, CNBC, CNN and Fox Business. He has also been quoted in *BusinessWeek*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Washington Post* and many other leading publications.
